STOMP can provide workshops to include a combination of topics pertaining to military families. The workshop agenda for each installation will be tailored to meet the needs and concerns of families. Staff and planners will take into account the unique needs and location of the installation.

Workshop topics can include:

- In depth information about parents rights and responsibilities (IDEA, 504, DODEA, FERPA, IEP, IFSP) in achieving special education services for their children whether located in the United States or overseas.
- Accessing educational and medical records and developing a comprehensive home file.
- Accessing resources in both current duty stations and future assignments thus expediting transition to services and resources.
- Making informed decisions with respect to overseas assignments & DODEA.
- Working effectively with military systems such as TRICARE, ECHO, and the EFMP.

The typical costs for a 2 day workshop CONUS will be \$2,500, plus travel reimbursement, accommodation and per diem.

Typical costs for an overseas workshop are \$5,000, plus travel reimbursement, accommodation and per diem.
