



Cost of Services Available Through STOMP

1. **Direct consultation with families:** 1:1 training and assistance with special education planning and development of parent advocacy in accessing resources, regardless of geographic location.

2. **Technical assistance to professionals:** regarding laws, regulations and rules pertaining to military families and direction on issues unique to those families in the area of special education and medical resources.

3. **Materials:** The Project, in collaboration with Washington PAVE, has a variety of materials available. Please see our materials page.
4. **Information and Referral:** The Project is part of a national alliance of Parent Training and Information Centers. We are able to refer families to their state PTI and other useful local and national resources, both military and civilian, as appropriate.

6. **Workshops:** The Project can provide workshops to include a combination of topics pertaining to military families. The workshop agenda of each installation will be tailored to best meet the needs and concerns of families at the specific installation, taking into account the unique location of the installation. Workshop topics can include:
 - Working with the educational or early intervention planning teams to access services.
 - Accessing educational and medical records and developing a comprehensive home file.
 - Accessing resources in both current duty stations and future assignments enabling expedient transition to new services.
 - Making informed decisions with respect to overseas assignments & DODEA.
 - Working effectively with military systems such as Tri-Care, and the EFMP.

Typical costs for a 2 day workshop CONUS will be \$2,500, plus travel reimbursement, accommodation and per diem. Typical costs for an overseas workshop are \$5,000, plus travel reimbursement, accommodation and per diem. Materials can be reproduced by the Project and billed to the installation, or master copies can be provided with consent for reproduction.

7. **The PPTW Network:** The Project facilitates a national network of teams who have previously attended the annual Parent Professional Teams Workshop. Each year the Project welcomes 8 teams of 3, comprised of a military parent, a military professional and a PTI member, for a comprehensive 4.5-day workshop, to train teams to serve military families of individuals with disabilities at their local level. As the network builds, the Project is able to refer families to these local contacts as an additional resource. **Travel and accommodation for the workshop is provided by the Project with a registration fee for participants.** For additional information about the PPTW and/or an application form, please contact the STOMP Headquarters at (253) 565-2266 (v/tty) or 1-800-572-7368 (v/tty).
